Chlorhexidine Wash Cloths for patient cleansing








(Single patient use only. Use one wipe per area of the body.)

 <p>Perform hand hygiene before using Clinell Chlorhexidine Wash Cloths</p>	 <p>Open the pack of Clinell Chlorhexidine Wash Cloths and remove one wipe by pulling back the resealable label</p>	 <p>Use the wash cloth for your neck and torso</p>	 <p>Use a new wash cloth for your left arm and armpit</p>
 <p>Use a new wash cloth for your right arm and armpit</p>	 <p>Use a new wash cloth for your groin (not for use on genitals)</p>	 <p>Use a new wash cloth for your left leg, including your foot</p>	 <p>Use a new wash cloth for your right leg, including your foot</p>
 <p>Use a new wash cloth for your back</p>	 <p>Use a new wash cloth for your buttocks</p>	 <p>Dispose of wash cloths. In a healthcare setting - dispose in line with local protocols</p>	 <p>Perform hand hygiene on completion of application</p>
